Guidelines:

1. Each student may only submit one entry (schools are encouraged to submit all entries that it receives to the district)
2. The entries must be delivered to the Clarendon Soil and Water Conservation District office by 4:30pm on Thursday, November 10, 2016.
3. Kindergarten students may draw a picture to illustrate the theme as they may not be capable of writing a poem.
4. All entries must be attached to a sheet of construction paper, 11" x 8 1/2", with the following information:
 - Name of Student
 - Grade
 - Student Address
 - Name of School
 - Name of Teacher
 - School's Address



Judging/Awards:

1. Poems will be judged on originality, neatness, and overall effectiveness of the message.
2. A county winner in each grade level will be chosen
3. Each winner will receive \$20 and a certificate
4. Awards will be presented to the winners at a date designated by the teacher.
