

The Clarendon Soil & Water Conservation District's 2016 Farm City Scarecrow Contest

Participants:

All students in grades 3-8 attending public and private schools in Clarendon County.

Guidelines:

- Student may create a scarecrow by either drawing, coloring, or creating a poster or a collage (category 1), or by creating a free standing scarecrow out of recycled materials (category 2).
- Drawings, colorings, posters or collages must not be larger than 36" x 48"
- Free standing scarecrows must not be taller than 20"
- All entries must have the following information attached:
 1. Student Name
 2. Grade
 3. Name of School
 4. Name of Teacher
- The entries must be delivered to the Clarendon Soil and Water Conservation District office by 4:30p.m. on Thursday, November 10, 2016.

Judging/Awards:

- Scarecrows will be judged on creativity, originality, "Farm City Spirit", and the use of recycled materials.
- A 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner will be named in each category, for each grade level.
- Each winner will receive cash prize and a certificate.
